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# LET'S DRAW A TREE!

## Learning Objectives:

This is a short activity designed to accompany longer lesson plans. Students will draw and discuss trees, while paying particular attention to the common components of trees.

## Required Materials:

- ❖ Attached worksheet
- ❖ Pencils / pens / markers / crayons
- ❖ Optional: clipboards / portable writing surface

## Directions:

At Save the Giants Park, or in the classroom, have students complete the attached worksheet. Explain to the students that they may choose to draw a tree that they have seen before, or they can work from their imagination. After they have completed the assignment, have your students discuss *what* each of the listed components is, and *what* it looks like. What color are the parts of a tree? Do the different parts look the same on *every* tree? Or do some parts—like leaves—look different on different trees?

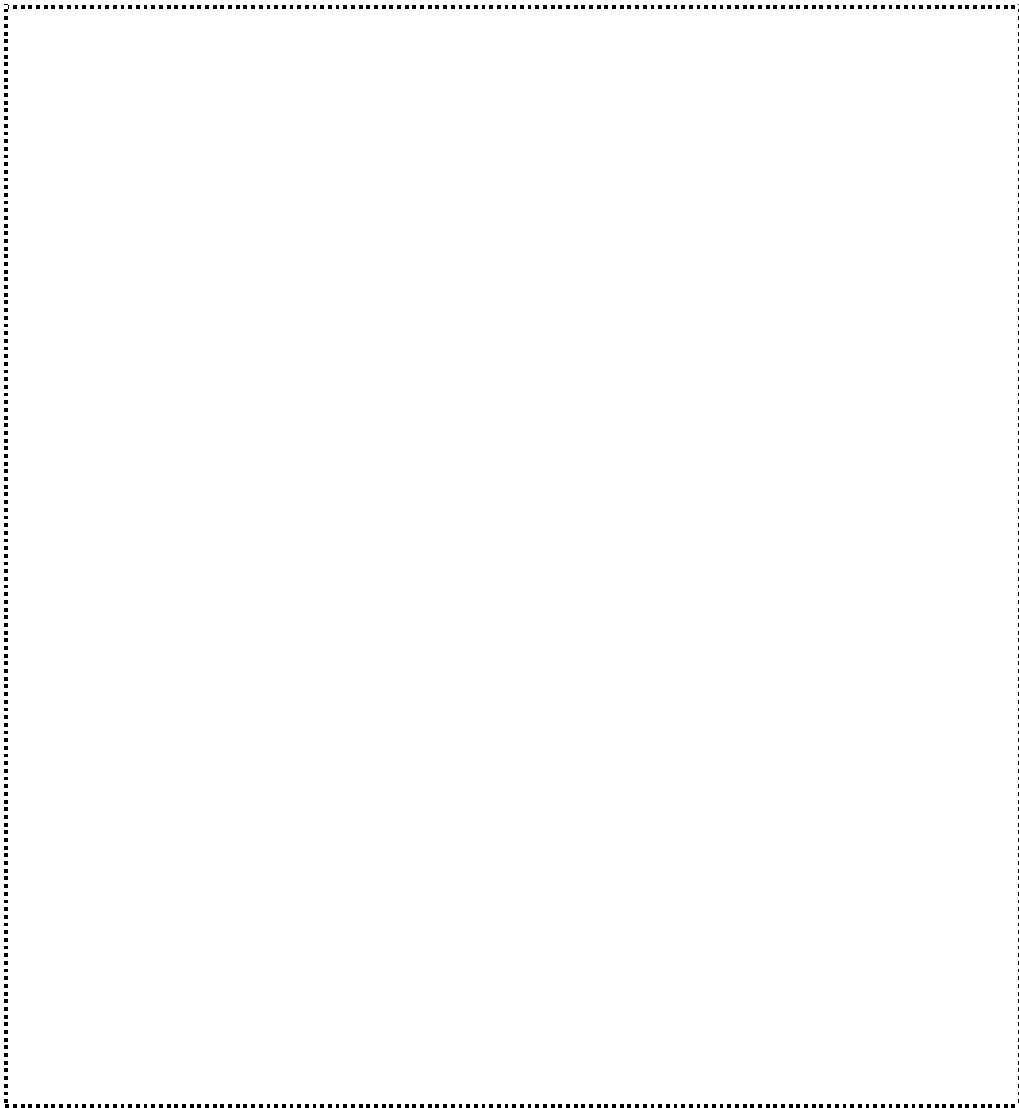
# Let's Draw a Tree!
