LET'S DRAW A TREE!

Kindergarten - 2nd Grade Science / Art 20 Minutes Related Lesson Plans:



- Parts of a Tree
- What's in the Bag?

Learning Objectives:

This is a short activity designed to accompany longer lesson plans. Students will draw and discuss trees, while paying particular attention to the common components of trees.

Required Materials:

- ♦ Attached worksheet
- Pencils / pens / markers / crayons
- Optional: clipboards / portable writing surface

Directions:

At Save the Giants Park, or in the classroom, have students complete the attached worksheet. Explain to the students that they may choose to draw a tree that they have seen before, or they can work from their imagination. After they have completed the assignment, have your students discuss *what* each of the listed components is, and what it looks like. What color are the parts of a tree? Do the different parts look the same on *every* tree? Or do some parts—like leaves—look different on different trees?

Make sure that your tree has each of the parts that are listed!

If you want, you can also add fruit, cones, or flowers to your tree!
